- Discussion of the History of English Literature. Divide class into groups and ask them to form posters highlighting the major periods from Old English to the nineteenth century and present their learnings. Students will be able to identify the major periods of English literature.
- Encourage student participation in the form of reading texts, discussion of relevant topics, raising questions, etc. with the purpose of checking their communicative skills and improve on them, if needed.
